Dear Brian Carr:

The Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel of the State Bar of Texas has received and examined your grievance against the above-named individual. When a grievance is received, this office conducts an initial review to determine whether the alleged conduct would be a violation of the ethics rules. If the conduct does not allege a violation, the grievance is classified as an Inquiry and dismissed with a right to appeal the dismissal. If the conduct alleges a violation, the grievance is classified as a Complaint and investigated. We have determined that the conduct described in your grievance involves actions taken by an individual/attorney in their capacity as a judge. Therefore, your grievance has been classified as an Inquiry and dismissed pursuant to rule 2.10 of the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure (TRDP). Allegations of judicial misconduct by federal judges need to be directed to the clerk's office of the United States court of appeals for the regional circuit in which the judge serves. If your complaint is against a Texas federal judge, please contact the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals.

If you wish to appeal our determination to the Board of Disciplinary Appeals, you must use the enclosed form and submit it directly to the Board of Disciplinary Appeals. You have thirty (30) days from your receipt of this letter to appeal this determination.

In compliance with the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure, the Office of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel maintains confidentiality throughout the grievance process. If you have any questions about the dismissal of your grievance, I can be reached at (877) 953-5535.
